PATIENT INFORMATION

Hours Open: Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays – 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Patient Criteria:

1. Prospective patients who are eligible for Medicare, Medicaid or CHIPS; government insurance, including VA; or have private health insurance, will not qualify for Clinic services.
2. Patients must be re-certified annually to be eligible for Clinic services. Household income may not exceed 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines. (See chart below.)

Household income may not exceed 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG):

Suggested Donations:

Patients with household incomes between 100% and 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines are asked to make a contribution to the Clinic to help pay for their healthcare. A donation amount is suggested by the Clinic staff, based on a sliding scale of household income and the medical service required.

Patients with household incomes of 100% of FPG or less are not asked to make a contribution to the Clinic regardless of the medical service required.

The Clinic has no billing system; we simply ask for a contribution with a suggested amount. It is up to the patient whether he/she chooses to pay it. We do not refuse treatment if the patient is not able to make a contribution. But the patient needs to know that our major funding sources pay attention to what our patients contribute, and the amount that patients contribute influences their funding decisions. They typically ask for the number of patients who contribute. So any amount donated—whether five dollars or ten dollars or more—improves the Clinic’s chances of receiving continued support from major funding sources.

Appointment Procedure:

Prospective patients fill out an application to see if they qualify for Clinic healthcare services. Once approved, they can call **830-796-3448** to make an appointment.
